Each ARTIST TABLE includes the following:

One (1) table in the Artist Alley area (6' or 8' - based on availability)

Two (2) chairs

One (1) weekend pass to the convention labeled "Artist"

PLEASE NOTE:

- Artist Alley is juried. This means that we review all applications and a committee from the event operations staff chooses the artists who will be approved. This is done in order to make sure a variety of art styles are made available to the attendees – thus avoiding creators all selling the same style/presentation.
- Up to one (1) additional ARTIST pass can be purchased (per space) for \$25.
- Power and Internet access are available. Please see Section IV.
- Artist Alley table sales will end on **October 15, 2018**.

Artist Alley tables are \$125 for WasabiCon 2018.

SECTION IV: INTERNET ACCESS & POWER

Wireless **internet access** will be made available to ARTISTS via the host property. Please see the on-site ARTIST Coordinator for the Wi-fi password during load in. **Power** outlets are available, but are on a first come/first served basis. We recommend bringing an extension cord and power strip (just in case!) since sharing is encouraged. Please keep in mind that all cabling and/or extension cord use must be approved by Green Mustard Entertainment event management (on site) for safety purposes.

SECTION VII: POLICIES (PLEASE READ COMPLETELY!)

- All ARTISTS and their staff are responsible for adhering to the Convention Rules and Weapons Policy posted online at www.WasabiCon.com/policies
- The assignment of your table's location will be solely at the discretion of Green Mustard Entertainment management. While we will do our best to accommodate every request, we cannot guarantee a specific space.
- ARTIST packets containing badges and any other pertinent paperwork will be available for pickup before the event begins. Check www.WasabiCon.com/artists for the scheduled set up times and hours of operation. Packets must be retrieved and badges worn before you are allowed to set up your space. These packets will not be mailed in advance for any reason.
- Your ARTIST space will be considered confirmed upon receipt of a signed agreement with full payment. Partial payments and *verbal* agreements do not constitute a confirmed space or guarantee of any kind.
- Any cancellations must be received in writing no later than forty-five (45) days in advance of the event. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any cancellations. Cancellations are not permitted after fourteen (14) calendar days before the start of the event and all fees (partial or complete) are non-refundable after that point. All refunds will be sent via U.S. Mail or via our online ticketing system within forty-five (45) days after the conclusion of the event.
- Setup and breakdown times at the convention are strictly enforced. Your table should be open and available for business during the officially posted Artist Alley hours. Breakdown of your space should not begin before the Artist Alley closure time listed on your signed application.
- Bootleg merchandise (aka "grey market goods" - any/all unlicensed products and reproductions of any kind) including but not limited to imports, weapons, costumes, accessories, and all products containing trademarked properties is not authorized for sale in any Green Mustard Entertainment Artist Alley or Exhibitors Hall.
- ARTISTS agree that no weapon or adult material shall be purchased by or handled by any person below the legal age of 18. You are responsible for furnishing adequate information to Green Mustard Entertainment as to the proper removal of a weapon or adult material from the convention after purchase.
- Green Mustard Entertainment reserves the right to revoke or refuse any application or to deny access to and/or remove dealers from the event at any time.
- Green Mustard Entertainment is not responsible for losses due to theft, damage, fire, acts of nature, acts of God, or other causes.
- You are responsible for providing your own insurance, and neither Green Mustard Entertainment nor the hotel/convention center/event venue will be responsible for obtaining insurance for you, your company, or your/its employees.
- It is your responsibility to collect, report, and pay sales tax and/or fees according to federal, state, county and city regulations. Information and forms can be found online at
